1. Strategic participation

- Total Capacity: 12 participants from Wenzhou Medical University
- Structure: The project is divided into 2 editions (6 participants per group).
- Target Group: Academic teachers (Health Profession Educators) and Medical Simulation Technicians.

2. Micro-programme structure

- On-site Training (Lublin, Poland): * 6 days of intensive simulation instructor training.
- 40 hours of practical workshops at the Medical University of Lublin Simulation Center.
- Online Workshop: * 6-hour joint training session on Multicultural Competence.
- Collaborative session with global peers.

3. Certification (Micro-credentials)
